Doctoral students receive tuition and a living stipend for three years, with opportunities to apply for additional research funds. Students can extend the funded period of their PhD studies by applying for CEU Doctoral Research Support, which funds study abroad.

CEU also supports this additional study abroad in the form of exchange agreements with other universities and through supporting students applying for external scholarships in European and American universities and research centers for non-degree study.
